A project exploring young people's own identity and values.

A collaborative project involving Dunham Trust, The Whitworth and Stepping Stones as Creative Directors.

The medium was dance, visual arts and drama.

Our aim was to advocate for our children to be included in cultural institutions with access to high quality aspirational artists.



Future Traces



Stimulated by the Barbara Brown patterns and textile exhibition at The Whitworth. Looking at traces we might leave. From this exhibition space the children will stream their work to four schools of over a 1000 peers.



Forming their traces in clay



The children used clay to explore what they might leave behind – their identity



Listen, Cooperate and Change



Using applied drama, the young people explored the hierarchical structure within the school and how that could be changed using chairs to shape the hierarchy from a triangular to circular configuration.
